RBI imposes Rs 35 lakh penalty on TMB

- The Reserve Bank has imposed a penalty of Rs 35 lakh on Tamilnad Mercantile Bank for violating norms on frauds classification and notification. The RBI said in a release that it imposed the fine via an order dated October 24, 2019.
- It stated that the bank has been penalised for non-compliance with certain provisions of directions issued by RBI on frauds classification and reporting by commercial banks and select FIs directions 2016.

World Bank to fund USD 6 bn annual lending support to India

- World Bank, the multi-lateral funding agency, has announced that it is to continue providing a \$6 billion annual lending target for India to support infrastructure development and alleviate poverty.
- The announcement was made by President of World Bank David Malpass during his visit in the backdrop of the recently released World Bank report on Ease of Doing Business 2020.
- As of now, around 97 projects are being currently executed in India with loan assistance from the World Bank. For the 97 projects, it has provided \$24 billion. It is expected that the program will continue and reflect on the projects and reforms that were going on in India.

Axis Bank launches Express FD

• Private sector lender Axis Bank, announced the launch of a digital fixed-deposit product. Called 'Express FD', a customer can open an Express FD account in three minutes through the digital mode without opening a savings account with the bank.

Bank of Baroda signs MoU with Indian Army for new, customised banking experience

- Bank of Baroda, the country's second largest public sector bank, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Army.
- Through this MoU, the bank has assured a new and customised banking experience for both serving and retired personnel of Indian Army.

RBI slaps Rs 1 cr penalty on Bandhan Bank over promoter holding norms

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed Rs 1 crore penalty on Bandhan Bank for non-compliance with promoter holding norms.
- The RBI said that the bank was required to bring down the shareholding of its "non-operative financial holding company" to 40 per cent of its paid-up equity capital within a period of three years from the date of commencement of business of the bank.

New India Assurance Company signs Inter Creditor Agreements (ICAs) with Reliance HF, Dewan HF

• For its exposure to debt instruments of Reliance Home Finance and Dewan Housing Finance. New India Assurance Company has signed the Deed of Accession for entering into the Inter Creditor Agreements for the Company's exposure to the Debt instruments of Reliance Home Finance and Dewan Housing Finance.

RBI cuts repo rate by 25 bps to 5.15%, maintains accommodative stance

- The six-member Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of the Reserve Bank of India slashed the short-term lending rate, repo rate, by 25 basis points in its fourth bimonthly policy review.
- This was the fifth consecutive rate cut effected by the Shaktikanta Das-led panel, and it was in addition to a cumulative 110 basis points rate cut that RBI has announced so far this year. The repo rate now stands at 5.15 per cent, the lowest since March 2010.

ICICI Bank partners CSC e-Governance Services India to expand rural reach

• ICICI Bank signed a pact with CSC e-Governance Services India to extend its banking and other services to the country's rural regions. "As per the MoU (memorandum of understanding), ICICI Bank will engage more than 3 lakh CSCs (common service centres) working at the last mile as banking correspondents," CSC e-Governance Services India and ICICI said in a joint statement.

Uco Bank announces launch of 3 new digital products

PayPal is launching a Venmo credit card to help monetize the payment app

- PayPal is partnering with Synchrony Financial to launch a credit card for Venmo users. The popular peer-to-peer mobile payments app has attracted 40 million users but hasn't been able to turn a profit for its parent company.

ADB Grants \$37 Million for a 47.5 MW Floating Solar Project in Vietnam

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has signed a \$37 million loan agreement that would finance the installation of a 47.5 MW floating solar project in Vietnam.
- The global lender has signed the agreement with Da Nhim-Ham Thuan-Da Mi Hydro Power Joint Stock Company (DHD) to facilitate the floating solar installation on the man-made reservoir of DHD's existing 175 MW Da Mi hydropower project.

BoB, BNP Paribas arms to merge mutual fund biz

 Baroda Asset Management India, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Bank of Baroda and BNP Paribas Asset Management India, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas Asset Management Asia (BNPP AM), will merge their mutual fund business, subject to regulatory approvals.

• Both Bank of Baroda and BNP Paribas Asset Management Asia have entered into a binding agreement to merge their business which involves no cash consideration, said BoB in a statement.

SBI launches debit card EMI on POS

- The State Bank of India (SBI) has launched an EMI (equated monthly instalment) facility for its existing debit card customers. According to a press release issued by the bank, under the scheme, card holders will be able to avail the loans via point-of-sale (POS) machines across India.
- They can buy the products at 40,000+ merchants and stores in 1,500+ cities having Pine Labs branded POS machines totaling.

State Bank of India cuts interest rates on savings accounts, fixed deposits

• SBI announced revision in interest rate on savings accounts with balances up to Rs 1 lakh from 3.50% to 3.25%. Bank also slashed its retail and bulk term deposit rates by 10 bps and 30 bps respectively for 1 year to less than 2 years tenor. The interest rates on savings account deposits above Rs 1 lakh has been kept unchanged

RBI rejects Indiabulls Housing, Lakshmi Vilas Bank's proposed merger

• The Reserve Bank of India has rejected the proposed merger between Lakshmi Vilas BankNSE and Indiabulls Housing FinanceNSE, the lender said. The bank didn't reveal the reason cited for the central bank's decision.

GeM signs MoU with Union Bank of India

- Government e-Marketplace (GeM) signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Union Bank of India (UBI). Through this partnership, UBI will be able to offer array of services including transfer of funds through GeM Pool Accounts (GPA), advising of Performance Bank Guarantees (e-PBG) and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) to the registered users on the GeM portal.
- It will also facilitate cashless, paperless and transparent payment system on GeM portal and will create an efficient procurement system for government entities.

World Bank forecasts Indias GDP forecast to 6 percent

- World Bank said that India's growth rate is projected to fall to 6% in 2019-20 following the deceleration in the initial quarters of this fiscal.
- World Bank said that India is expected to gradually recover to 6.9% in FY21 and 7.2% in FY22 in its latest edition of the South Asia Economic Focus. In April 2019, World Bank projected India's growth rate as 7.5%.

ICICI Bank sells entire stake in GST Network to 13 state governments

• Private sector ICICI Bank said it has exited the GST Network, the company facilitating collection of the indirect tax, by selling its entire 10 per cent stake to as many as 13 state governments.

• The stake sale is for aggregate cash consideration of ₹1 crore, ICICI Bank said in a regulatory filing.

India calls for increased cooperation between FATF and UN

• To deal with the nexus of terrorist groups India called for increased cooperation between the United Nations (UN) and the Financial Action Task Force (FATF). Speaking at the General Assembly the first Secretary to India's Permanent Mission said that the activities of terror groups Boko Haram, ISIL, AI Shabab has increased in recent days. In these situations, UN should cooperate with other bodies like FATF to prevent terrorism.

- Ladakh was made an independent union territory after the government recently revoked Article 370.

World Guinness Record for lighting 4 lakh diyas

IMF lowers growth estimate to 6.1%

• The International Monetary Fund cut its estimate for India's growth this year to 6.1% from 7% projected in July, calling on the country to use monetary policy and broadbased structural reforms to address cyclical weakness and strengthen confidence.

Basic ministerial meet on climate change

- The 29th ministerial meet of BASIC countries was held at Beijing between October 25-26, 2019. The BASIC countries include Brazil, South Africa, India and China.
- BASIC countries
- The BASIC countries are the block of Brazil, India, China and South Africa formed based on an agreement in 2009. They committed to act jointly at the Copenhagen Climate Summit. The countries announced plans and targets accordingly. The grouping also agreed to provide technical aid to G77 countries.

US to host 2020 G7 summit at a Donald Trump golf resort

• The G7 Summit in 2020 would be held at President Donald Trump's golf resort in Florida and would cost half the amount than hosting the event at another place, the White House has claimed, rejecting criticism that he "used" his public office to secure big contract for himself.

World Bank President David Malpass to visit India, Pakistan later this month

MOSAIC Expedition in Arctic

- Among 300 scientists from the world, a 32 year polar researcher from Kerala will be the only person to join MOSAIC expedition MOSAIC expedition MOSAIC is Multidisciplinary drifting Observatory for the Study of Arctic Climate.
- It is the largest Arctic expedition in the history. It is being conducted Alfred Wegner Institute of Germany. It helps researchers understand the impact of climate change. The expedition intends to parameterize geophysical, atmospheric and oceanographic variables of Arctic.

Abu Dhabi Pearl-

• The Pearl was found below layers that have been radiocarbon dated to 5,800-5,600 BCE, during the Neolithic period. The discovery of the oldest pearl is proof that pearls and oysters were being used in the UAE nearly 8,000 years ago. It also represents the earliest known evidence for pearling yet discovered anywhere in the world.

G20 Health Ministers Meeting

• The Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare attended the G20 Okayama Health Minister Meeting that was held between October 19 and October 20, 2019. It was held under the Presidency of Japan.

Qantas sets record with nearly 20-hour commercial flight from New York to Sydney

- Australia's Qantas on Sunday completed the first non-stop commercial flight from New York to Sydney, which was used to run a series of tests to assess the effects of ultra long-haul flights on crew fatigue and passenger jetlag.
- The Boeing 787 Dreamliner touched down in Sydney early Sunday morning after a flight of 19 hours and 16 minutes the world's longest.

NAM Summit, 2019

- The Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) Summit is to be held in Baku, Azerbaijan. The summit is to be held between October 25 and October 26, 2019. The 18th NAM summit will be preceded by Ministerial meetings and senior official meetings.
- NAM The Non-Alignment Movement was founded in 1961. It was based on Bandung principles that was adopted at the Belgrade Summit (an Afro-Asian Conference) in 1955.
- It was founded during the collapse of colonial system and independence struggles of Asia, Africa and Latin American countries. The movement worked towards the attainment of independence for many countries. India is a founding member of the NAM summit.

Sri Lanka removed from FATF's Grey List

• Sri Lanka has been removed from 'Grey List' of Financial Action Task Force (FATF) following the new measures taken by the country on financial security. The word 'Grey List' identified by FATF refers to a jurisdiction with strategic Anti-Money Laundering and Countering the Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT) deficiencies.

Justin Trudeau's Liberal Party wins Canada's general election

- Election results show Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's Liberal Party will return to power, but as a minority government after Monday's general election, according to CBC News and CTV News.
- The victory ensures that Trudeau will serve as Prime Minister for a second term. Trudeau spoke to a cheering crowd in Montreal about his victory.

Fifa under fire after announcing China will host 24-team Club World Cup

• World football's governing body has confirmed that an expanded version of its showpiece event, featuring 24 teams, will take place there in June and July 2021. The decision was made despite China's suppression of pro-democracy protests in Hong Kong, and the internment of more than one million Uighur Muslims in the state of Xinjiang.

Twitter to ban all political advertising

Twitter is to ban all political advertising worldwide, saying that the reach of such messages "should be earned, not bought". "While internet advertising is incredibly powerful and very effective for commercial advertisers, that power brings significant risks to politics," company CEO Jack Dorsey tweeted.

• Minister of Petroleum & Natural Gas and Steel Shri Dharmendra Pradhan is on a 3-day visit to Mongolia from 7 October to 9 October 2019. He is accompanied by an official and business delegation. The visit is a follow up of the State visit the President of Mongolia to India in the month of September 2019.

India to set up coastal radar system in Bangladesh

• India and Bangladesh have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to set up a coastal surveillance radar system in Bangladesh to harness bilateral defence cooperation and to build a closer maritime security partnership between the two countries.

Narendra Modi-Xi Jinping 'informal summit' in Chennai from October 11

- Chinese President Xi Jinping will arrive in Chennai on October 11 for the second "informal summit" with Prime Minister Narendra Modi, New Delhi and Beijing announced on October 9.
- The meeting between the two leaders, that follows the Wuhan summit last April that reset ties, is expected to enhance bilateral cooperation.

India-Saudi Arabia sign MoUs during PM Modi visit

• PM Modi visited Saudi Arabia to attend the Future Investment Initiative. During his visit, the two sides held bilateral talks during which they reviewed historical and close relations between the countries.

India signs MoU with Saudi Arabia to launch RuPay card in Gulf Kingdom

• India signed an agreement with Saudi Arabia to launch the RuPay card in the country, making it the third nation in the West Asia to initiate India's digital payment system which will benefit not only the 2.6 million Indians in the Gulf Kingdom but also Haj and Umrah pilgrims.

Rajnath Singh to represent India at SCO heads of state meeting

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh will represent India at the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) heads of state meeting, which is to be held in Uzbekistan on 2 November. Mr. Singh is to embark on a three-day visit to Uzbekistan from 1-3 November.
- He will also hold a meeting with Uzbekistan's defence minister. Both Ministers will discuss military cooperation. It is expected that they will conclude discussions on two pacts on military education and cooperation and military medicine.

Members of EU meet PM Modi; visit Kashmir

- A 28-member delegation from European Union met PM Modi on October 28, 2019. The delegation will visit Kashmir on October 29, 1019. The delegation is to check on the reality of the situation in Kashmir.

- The last visit was in 1990 by the then president, Ramaswamy Venkatraman. He attended the enthronement ceremonies of Emperor Emeritus Akihito, who stepped down in 2018.

Bharat Mumbai Container Terminals becomes fastest to reach one million container handling milestone

• Bharat Mumbai Container Terminals (BMCT), the facility run by Singapore's PSA International Pte Ltd at Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust (JNPT) near Mumbai, handled its one millionth twenty-foot equivalent units (TEUs) last week, becoming the fastest to reach the feat for a terminal in India.

• India has moved 14 places to be 63rd among 190 nations in the World Bank's ease of doing business ranking released on the back of multiple economic reforms by the

- Narendra Modi government. However, it failed to achieve government's target of being at 50th place.
- The country was 77th among 190 countries in the previous ranking last year, an improvement by 23 places. The report assess improvement in ease of doing business environment in Delhi and Mumbai.

• Three railway stations in Rajasthan bagged top honours in the railways' cleanliness survey unveiled by Railway Minister Piyush Goyal. It was the also second company to reach Rs.8 lakh crore mark.

 Navaratna Defence PSU Bharat Electronics (BEL) has signed an MoU with Tamil Nadu Industrial Explosives Limited (TEL), a state-government undertaking of the Government of Tamil Nadu, for co-operation in the explosives segment where BEL is eyeing business growth, keeping in view its ongoing and upcoming ammunition programs.

SoftBank and Oyo in \$100m plus deal for Japan apartment operator

- SoftBank Group and Indian hotel startup Oyo have jointly acquired an 80% stake in Japanese rental apartment operator MDI.
- The acquisition cost over \$100 million, according to a person familiar with the deal. Oyo confirmed the transaction but declined to comment on either the price or its stake in the joint venture set up to acquire MDI. SoftBank and MDI also declined to comment.

Nippon Life invests Rs 6,000 cr to emerge largest shareholder in Reliance MF

- Japan's Nippon Life Insurance has completed an investment of Rs 6,000 crore in the erstwhile Reliance Mutual Fund to emerge as the single largest shareholder, with 75 per cent stake.
- Following this, the Japanese company has renamed Reliance Mutual Fund as Nippon India Mutual Fund and has started the integration of operations with its Global Unified Asset Management business.

Exercise Nomadic Elephant XIV commenced on 6th October in Bakloh

• The Exercise Nomadic Elephant XIV, 14th edition of Indo–Mongolian joint military training has commenced from 6 October 2019. The exercise is conducted over a period of 14 days from 6 October to 18 October 2019 at Bakloh, Himachal Pradesh.

India- Bangladesh Navies to participate in maiden bilateral drill at Visakhapatnam

 Navies of India and Bangladesh will participate for the first time in a IN-BN Bilateral Exercise at Visakhapatnam from 12 to 16 October 2019. This exercise which takes place a week after Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's visit to India, will entail development of mutual communication and sharing of best practices, thus adding a new dimension to India- Bangladesh maritime relations.

Indian Army inducts US made precision-guided Excalibur artillery ammunition

• To boost to its firepower, the Indian army has inducted US made precision-guided Excalibur artillery ammunition and indigenous Dhanush howitzer in its inventory. The announcement regarding ammunition's induction was made in an Army Commander's Conference.

Indian Army launches "OASIS"

• The Indian Army has begun to digitize its official records under its new programme called "OASIS"-Officers Automated Structures Information System. Under the programme, the records of the army officers are to be digitized. The software is to be hosted in the Army's intranet.

DRDO signs 30 agreements on Technology Transfer

- Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) signed 30 licensing agreements for Transfer of Technology (ToT) with 16 Indian companies. The company includes three start-ups, at Vibrant Goa Global Expo and Summit 2019.
- The conference is held at Goa University, Taleigao, Goa, between October 17-19, 2019. The DRDO develops technologies for the Armed Forces to the defense industry for the end-users of the Armed Forces.

DRDOs AIP system is boosted with the operation of land based prototype

- Indian military's research and development agency, Defence Research and Development Organisation's (DRDO) programme to build a fuel cell-based Air Independent Propulsion (AIP) system for Indian Naval Submarines, was conducted at the Naval Materials Research Laboratory in Ambernath, Maharashtra.
- The programme provides great value to the nation and the Indian Navy in particular. The Operation of the land-based prototype engineered to the form-and-fit of a submarine was witnessed by Chief of the Naval Staff Admiral Karambir Singh.

Ekuverin 2019: Indo Maldives joint Exercise

 Indian Army and the Maldives National Defence Force participated in a Joint Military Exercise called 'Ekuverin' at Aundh Military Station in Pune, Maharashtra. This year was the tenth edition of the joint military exercise which was organised from 7 to 20 October 2019

Exercise KAZIND 2019 is being held at Pithoragarh

• Exercise KAZIND-2019, a joint military exercise, between India and Kazakhstan is being held in Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand. The 12-day exercise was inaugurated by Brig SK Mandal, Commander of the Ill Independent Infantry Brigade. It will conclude on 15 October 2019.

Indian Army begins its first mountain combat exercise 'Him Vijay' in Arunachal Pradesh

• The Indian army will begin its first ever mountain combat on October 7. The exercise is to test the mobility, coordination and communication of the troops in difficult terrain. The exercise is to be conducted in two phases.

Highlights of the exercise

- The first phase will be held between October 7 and October 10, 2019. The second phase will be held between October 20 and October 24, 2019.
- The exercise will include threes battle groups, each comprising of 4,000 soldiers. This is the largest military exercise in the history of Indian defense. The exercise includes mountain assault and air assault as well.

Indo-Japan Joint Military Exercise DHARMA GUARDIAN 2019

• Joint Military Exercise DHARMA GUARDIAN-2019 between India and Japan will be conducted at counter Insurgency and Jungle Warfare School, Vairengte from 19 Oct 2019 to 02 Nov 2019. Indian Army and Japanese Ground Self Defence Forces (JGSDF) comprising 25 soldiers each will participate in the exercise with an aim to share experience gained during various Counter-Terrorism Operations in respective Countries.

Vajra Prahar: India-US Joint Military Exercise, 2019

 A joint military training exercise "Vajra Prahar" is conducted in Seattle between October 13, 2019 and October 28, 2019. The exercise is conducted alternately in India and US. The Special Forces and the Southern Command of Indian Armed Forces will participate in the exercise

India celebrated its 87th Air Force Day on 8th October

• India celebrated its 87th Air Force Day on 8th October 2019. The year 2019 is special because the Indian Air force received the first of 36 long-awaited Rafale fighter jets. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, who is on a visit to France will receive the fighter jets.

 Union Ministry of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, Sowa Rigpa and Homoeopathy) and Ministry of Defence signed a MoU for integration of AYUSH under health establishments of Directorate General of Armed Forces Medical Services (DGAFMS) i.e. to provide traditional medicine services at the armed forces' hospitals and dispensaries.

India's Nex-Gen Hypersonic Missiles: DRDO begins manufacturing

• The DRDO begins manufacturing of hypersonic missiles. These missiles are five times faster than the speed of sound. DRDO is set to operate a wind tunnel to test and fine tune the technology

IAF to sign with HAL for 83 Tejas LCA

- The Indian Air Force (IAF) is to sign a deal with Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL) for acquiring 83 Tejas Light Combat Aircraft (LCA). The negotiations over the price of the fighter jets are almost done.
- In December 2017, the IAF issued a single-vendor tender to the HAL for procuring 83 LCA. The deal is yet to be signed. The delay is because negotiations that were held between IAF and HAL over the price of the aircraft.

Sindhu Sudarshan: Indian Army's exercise in deserts of Rajasthan

• Indian Army to conduct exercise codenamed as 'Sindhu Sudarshan' in the deserts of Rajasthan from 29 November to 4 December 2019. More than 40,000 troops will be participating in an all-arms battle array of Divisions and Brigades carrying out offensive

operations in deserts. The exercise will showcase a high degree of synergy between the Indian Army and Indian Air Force.

Exercise Shakti to be held from 31 October to 13 November

- Exercise Shakti-2019, a bilateral exercise between the Indian Army and French Army, is to be held at the Foreign Training Node at Mahajan Field Firing Ranges in Rajasthan from 31 October to 13 November.
- Aim:
- The Exercise Shakti aimed at counter-terrorism operations in the backdrop of semidesert terrain under the United Nations mandate.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Researchers see individual virus formation for the first time

The researchers of USA captured images of formation of viruses from particles. The
research provided a detailed view of mechanism with which the particles self –
assembled to form a parasite. The study was performed on single stranded RNA virus.
The researchers believe that this new advancement will help to find new treatment
approaches for viral diseases.

20 new moons of Saturn discovered

• 20 new moons of Saturn were discovered. With this Saturn has a total of 82 moons today. It is the highest of any planet in solar system. Till date Jupiter had the highest number of moons. It has 79 moons. The newly discovered moons belong to Norse group. The Saturn's Norse group of moons are retrograde irregular satellites.

Indian scientists discovered Plastic eating Bacteria

• Researchers at Shiv Nadar University have discovered two strains of plastic-eating bacteria from the wetlands of Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh. It is believed that this ecofriendly alternative might be used as a clean-up method for plastic waste worldwide.

MEV-1: 1st Satellite Servicing Spacecraft launched

• The robotic Mission Extension Vehicle-1 (MEV-1) was successfully launched atop of Russian Proton rocket from Baikonur Cosmodrome in Kazakhstan. It is first of its kind commercial satellite-servicing spacecraft. It is designed to dock with aging spacecraft more than 22,000 miles above Earth, then extend its life with aid of solar-electric thrusters. Its successful launch marks beginning of era of commercial satellite servicing in the space.

IIIT Hyderabad researchers create first ever Indian Brain atlas

• Researchers at the IIIT Hyderabad said that the first ever Indian Brain Atlas (IBA) has been created. They stated that the next step is to prepare atlases for different age groups to study age related affects on brain anatomy.

• The average brain size of an Indian was smaller in height, width and volume in comparison to people of the Caucasian and eastern races.

What is Cosmic Yeti?

• Scientists have accidentally discovered 'the footprints a monstrous galaxy' being called as 'Cosmic Yeti' in early universe that has never been seen before. The discovery provides new insights into the first growing steps of some of biggest galaxies in universe. The astronomical findings were published in Astrophysical Journal.

Scientists discovered a new and stable form of plutonium

• A team of scientists from Helmholtz Zentrum Dresden-Rossendorf (HZDR) has accidentally discovered a new and stable form of plutonium. The famously unstable element is difficult to transport, store, and dispose of. The scientist is finding new ways to tackle the problems.

A new Catalyst: To Convert Carbon Dioxide into Natural Gas

• The Engineers at the Stanford University have developed a new catalyst that helps to turn carbon dioxide from cars into fuels like propane or natural gas.

About the Research

- Catalysts induce chemical reactions without being used up in the reaction. In this new research scientists have combined ruthenium and iron oxide nano particles to form the new catalyst.
- The ruthenium nuggets sit in the core of the catalyst surrounded by an outer sheath of iron. This arrangement activates the hydrocarbon formation from Carbon-Dioxide.

Stable form of Plutonium discovered accidentally

- Scientists led by Helmholtz Zentrum Dresden Rossendorf have found new compound of Plutonium unexpectedly in France. The team was actually trying to create plutonium dioxide nano particles using different precursors.
- In the process, the plutonium at its pentavalent state showed a peculiar behavior. The scientists then learnt that the strange behavior of Plutonium at its pentavalent state was because it was stable! The team confirmed its stability using Pu M4 edge technology.

ISRO to develop Reusable Launch Vehicles

• The Indian Space Agency, Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), is currently developing a space program for Reusable Launch Vehicles (RLV). The Indian space agency has been testing the RLV since 2016.

Aim:

• The RLV program aims to reduce the launch costs by, well, reusing the spacecraft. Currently, ISRO's project is using a hybrid design type launch vehicle.

White bellbird is the worlds loudest bird

- Researchers from the University of Massachusetts in the U.S. have found that the White Bellbirds are the loudest bird in the world. They also found that the mating songs by the white male bellbird cause sound of thrice the decibels (dB) than the Screaming Piha during the mating period.
- The screaming Piha held the record by making the loudest call of around 125 dB.
- White bellbird:
- The white bellbird or Procnia albus is a bird species in the family Cotingidae. The bird is found in Guianas forest, Venezeula, Pará of Brazil. The male bird is white in colour, and the female is olive with yellowish streaks in colour.
