AIIB to invest 100 million USD in solar and wind projects in India

• The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) which is headquartered at Beijing expects an investment of 100 million USD in India in a year. The foreign investment is to enter India through the bank in Wind and solar projects. AIIB has so far invested 2.9 billion USD. It amounts to 30% of the total investment. India is the largest borrower of AIIB.

India and ADB sign 91 million USD to improve water resources in Karnataka

• On November 18, 2019, India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed a 91 million USD agreement to improve water security of Karnataka. The loan will help to modernize the Vijayanagara Channel irrigation systems and also to increase the efficiency of Krishna river basin.

IndiaFirst Life Insurance partners with Spice Money for 'Insurance Khata' product

• IndiaFirst Life Insurance has entered into a strategic & technical partnership with Spice Money, a tech-led financial services provider, for distribution / marketing of 'insurance khata' through the latter's platform, which has nearly 3 lakh customers. European Investment Bank to stop Fossil Fuel Funding by 2021

• The European Investment Bank is to stop funding oil and coal projects at the end of 2021. Since 2013, the European Union through the bank has funded 13.4 billion Euros for fossil fuel projects. In 2018, it was around 2 billion Euros. The Union has been reducing its funding to fossil fuel projects and is stopping by 2021.

RBI increases household income limits for borrowers of NBFCs and MFIs

• Reserve Bank of India increased the household income limits for borrowers of Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) and microfinance institutions (MFIs) from 1 lakh to 1.25 lakh rupees.

• Aim:

• The move is aimed at strengthening credit to those at the bottom of the economic pyramid in rural areas. The limit is increased from 1.6 lakh for urban or semi-urban areas to 2 lakh rupees. The limit has been increased after taking into consideration the important role played by microfinance institutions in delivering credit to those at the bottom of the economic pyramid and to enable them to play their assigned role in a growing economy.

- Tencent Holdings Ltd. has acquired a minority stake in Policybazaar.com valuing the Indian online insurance aggregator at \$1.5 billion, according to a person familiar with the deal, as it tries to get a foothold in the country's burgeoning insurance sector.
- The Chinese technology giant bought 10% of Policybazaar, half of Tiger Global Management LLC's stake in the company, the person said, asking not be identified as the matter was not public. The \$150 million deal was signed earlier this week, the person added.

Bajaj Allianz General Insurance launches 'Farmitra' app

- Bajaj Allianz General Insurance, the private general insurer launched industry's first mobile app 'Farmitra' catering to the specific needs of farmers. Through this app, farmers will not only get insurance solutions, but also a range of other information and advisories which will cater to their day to day farming needs.
- The Company, through this app intends to help farmers address their worries and provide them relevant information which they can use in optimizing their farming practices. This will create value for farmers, thereby increasing engagement with them.

Exim Bank gives \$30 million line of credit to Ghana

• Export-Import (Exim) Bank provided a \$30 million line of credit to Ghana for the potable water projects in the country. Exim Bank entered into an agreement with Ghana for a line of credit (LoC) of \$30 million (about Rs 210 crore) for financing rehabilitation and up-gradation of potable water system in Yendi, Ghana.

• Under the arrangement financing of export of eligible goods, works and services from India would be allowed subject to their being available for shipping under the Foreign Trade Policy of India and whose purchase may be agreed to be financed by the Exim Bank.

MSTC ties up with Allahabad Bank to develop e-auction platform

MSTC Ltd has signed an agreement with Allahabad Bank for the development of a
dedicated e-Auction platform directly linked with the Indian Banking Association's
portal (https://ibapi.net) for sale of non-performing assets (NPAs) through the
SARFAESI (Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of
Securities Interest) Act.

ADB to provide USD 451 mn for the CKIC corridor

- The Asian Development Bank is to provide a \$451 million loan to strengthen the power connectivity between southern and northern parts of the Chennai-Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor (CKIC) in Tamil Nadu.
- CKIC Project:
- The total estimated cost of the project is \$653.5 million, of which the government will provide \$202.5 million. The project has been estimated to be the completed date of the project is the end of 2024.

Aditya Birla Finance becomes first company to list commercial papers on stock exchanges

- Aditya Birla Finance Ltd (ABFL), the Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC) arm of Aditya Birla Capital, has now become the first company to list its commercial papers (CPs) on stock exchanges.
- The move comes after stock exchanges- the BSE (Bombay Stock Exchange) and NSE (National Stock Exchange), came out with a framework for listing of commercial papers (CPs), in a bid to broaden investors' participation in such securities.

From January, banks cannot charge you for online NEFT transactions

• From January 2020, banks can no longer charge savings bank account holders for online transactions in the NEFT system. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has now mandated banks to do this through a press release. In its press release, RBI stated that it is doing this to promote digital payments.

HDFC AMC, IGL added to MSCI India index, Yes Bank removed

 MSCI, the world's biggest index compiler, has added eight Indian stocks including HDFC Asset Management or HDFC AMC, Info Edge (India) and Indraprastha Gas Ltd to its India Index, while removing Vodafone Idea, Yes Bank and four others that have seen significant market capitalisation erosion this year.

PNB Housing Finance Raises Rs 2,500 Crore By Issuing Bonds To LIC

• Life Insurance Corporation of India has invested Rs 2,500 crore in PNB Housing Finance Ltd. by subscribing to the mortgage lender's secured redeemable non-convertible debentures. This issuance is on private placement basis with a door-to-door tenure of 10 years. The proceeds will be utilised by the company for its normal course of business operations.

Muthoot Finance to acquire IDBI Mutual Fund for ₹215 crore

• Gold loan financier Muthoot Finance has agreed to acquire IDBI Mutual Fund to foray into the mutual fund segment. As per the deal, it will acquire 100% shareholding in IDBI Asset Management for ₹215 crore. The mutual fund firm has assets worth over ₹5,300 crore under its management.

Ashok Leyland, ICICI Bank ink MoU for vehicle financing

- Commercial vehicle manufacturer Ashok Leyland Ltd. (ALL) has entered into a twoyear memorandum of understanding (MoU) with ICICI Bank to offer customised financial solutions to customers across India with a focus on semi-urban and rural geographies.
- With this MoU, ICICI Bank will be a preferred financier for providing finance to customers buying ALLAshok Leyland vehicles. The bank will work in close coordination with the authorised dealers of Ashok Leyland to provide financial solutions to the customers, said the company in a statement.

ADB Grants \$451 Million Loan to Boost Power Transmission Capacity in Tamil Nadu

• The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has sanctioned a \$451 million (~₹31.77 billion) loan to the state of Tamil Nadu for a project that will enable better power transfer between the southern part of the Chennai-Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor (CKIC) and the northern regions where there is higher power demand.

ADB approves \$300 million for power transmission expansion in Bangladesh

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) approved a 300 million dollar loan for a project to expand power transmission lines in Greater Dhaka and the western zone of Bangladesh.
- The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank has 200 million dollars in co-financing to fund transmission lines, substations, and an enterprise resource planning system. The assistance also comprises a 750,000 dollar grant from China's Poverty Reduction and Regional Cooperation Fund.

Wholesale inflation eases to 0.16 per cent in October

 Morgan Stanley Capital International (MSCI) recently re-balanced its India index under its semi-annual review. Of the eight additions it did to the index, two belong to the insurance sector – SBI Life and ICICI Prudential Life Insurance, possibly underlining brighter prospects in the segment.

World Bank to fund USD 300 million to the West Bengal

- World Bank announced that it is to fund \$300 million to the West Bengal State government. The announcement was made by the West Bengal Finance Minister Amit Mitra. The fund will be used for the development of logistics infrastructure within the city metropolitan area.

The AQI remained at 324 in Delhi, but it reached 414 in Patna.

The COP25 summit is aimed to bring out details of the implementation of the Paris Agreement climate pact.
- The 25th annual Climate Change Conference will feature the 25th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP 25) to the UNFCCC and the meetings of the UNFCCC subsidiary bodies.

World's first blockchain-based carbon trading exchange in Singapore

- Singapore-based AirCarbon Pte launched the worlds' first blockchain-based carbon trading exchange. This will allow airlines and other corporate buyers to buy as well sell tokens backed by carbon offset credits approved by the International Civil Aviation Organisation.
- The company is applying to the Monetary Authority of Singapore for a recognized market operator license and targets for the exchange to be fully operational in 2020, it said in a statement.

The 18th World Wind Energy Conference was held in Brazil

 World Wind Energy Association (WWEA) organized the 18th World Wind Energy Conference and Exhibition (WWEC2019) from 25-27 November 2019 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. The conference focused on opportunities offered by a renewable energy strategy.

270 mn people are migrants: World Migration Report 2020

• The number of international migrants globally reached an estimated 272 million in 2019, an increase of 51 million since 2010. Currently, international migrants comprise 3.5 per cent of the global population, compared to 2.8 per cent in the year 2000, according to new estimates released by the United Nations.

Last Sumatran rhino dies in Malaysia, smallest rhino species now extinct in Malaysia

- The last Sumatran rhinoceros in Malaysia died, leaving the smallest species of rhino which once roamed all across Asia even till India almost extinct with only around 80 rhinos alive, primarily in Indonesia.
- The last Sumatran rhino in Malaysia, a 25-year-old female named Iman, who has been cared for in a wildlife reserve since her capture in 2014, died of cancer in the state of Sabah on the island of Borneo. She had been suffering from uterine tumours since before her capture.

In bid to repair ties, Japan and South Korea agree to summit

- Japan and South Korea agreed on Saturday to hold formal talks next month, taking a step towards improving relations strained by decades of bitterness over their wartime past and now exacerbated by a simmering trade dispute.
- The decision to return to the table came a day after Seoul made a last-minute move to stick to an intelligence-sharing deal with Japan.
- The feud is rooted in a decades-old disagreement over compensation for South Korean labourers forced to work at Japanese firms during World War Two. Seoul has seized local assets of Japanese companies and Tokyo this year curbed exports of materials used to make semiconductors.

South African university, Unitaid tie up to develop child-friendly treatments for multi-drug resistant TB

• South Africa's Stellenbosch University and Unitaid have signed a \$18.9 million grant agreement to develop child-friendly treatments and preventive therapy for children suffering from multi-drug resistant tuberculosis (TB). The agreement was announced today at the ongoing 50th Union World Conference on Lung Health (WCOLH) in Hyderabad.

SCOJtEx-2019: Shanghai Cooperation Organization Joint Exercise

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah will inaugurate the Shanghai Cooperation Organization Joint Exercise on Urban Earthquake Search and Rescue- 'SCOJtEx-2019' in New Delhi. The four day exercise will be held from 4-7 November 2019. The joint exercise is being hosted by National Disaster Response Force (NDRF).
- The SCOJtEx will be followed by a meeting between SCO experts and officials of ministries responsible for prevention as well as elimination of emergency situations.

• The 6th ASEAN Defence Ministers' Meeting-Plus (ADMM-Plus) will be held in Bangkok, Thailand. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh along with 17 other Defence Ministers of ADMM-Plus countries will attend the meeting.

Microsoft's Bill Gates beats Amazon's Jeff Bezos as the world's richest person

- Microsoft co-founder Bill Gates overtook Amazon.com's Jeff Bezos as the world's richest person, reclaiming the top ranking for the first time in more than two years.
- Gates may have been helped in part by the Pentagon's surprise decision announced on October 25 to award a US\$10 billion cloud-computing contract to Microsoft over Amazon.

Dhaka International Folk Festival was celebrated at Bangladesh

• The fifth edition of the Dhaka International Folk Festival was held at Bangladesh Army Stadium, Bangladesh. It was inaugurated by the Information Minister of Bangladesh, Dr. Hasan Mahmud. - They also agreed to expand a protocol for poultry exports reached this year to include duck and geese as well as foie gras, and to work on a protocol allowing France to export pig semen to China, said a statement from Macron's office.

Iran discovers new oil field with 53 Bn barrels of reserves

• Iran has discovered a new oilfield with 53 billion barrels of crude oil in Khuzestan province, home to Iran's Khuzestan's crucial oil industry. The announcement however did not reveal how much oil could be produced from the reservoir but the find could boost country's battered economy amid stringent US sanctions.

Italy becomes first country to make climate change lessons compulsory for all children

- Italy is to become the first country to make climate change lessons compulsory for schoolchildren.
- Lorenzo Fioramonti, the education minister, has announced all state schools will dedicate almost one hour per week to climate change issues from the start of the next academic year.

ETVAX: Potential Diarrhea vaccine developed in Sweden

• The researchers of University of Gothenburg in Sweden have developed a potential Diarrhea vaccine candidate, named as 'ETVAX'. This vaccine has been proved safe and effective in an early-stage clinical trial in Bangladesh. The findings were published in Science journal, The Lancet.

Sri Lanka hosts biennial Commonwealth Law Ministers' Conference

- The biennial Commonwealth Law Ministers' Conference is being held in Colombo, Sri Lanka from 4-7 November 2019. India will be represented at the conference by Union Minister for Law and Justice Ravi Shankar Prasad.
- Theme for 2019 CLM Conference is- 'Equal Access to Justice and the Rule of Law'.
- Law Ministers and Attorney Generals from Commonwealth countries will be participating in the four-day conference. The conference will be chaired by Sri Lanka's Minister of Justice and Prison Reforms, Thalatha Atukorala.

Trump invites Xi Jinping to sign phase one of a bilateral trade deal

• The US President Donald Trump invited Chinese President Xi Jinping to sign phase one of a bilateral trade deal when it is agreed upon. The trade talks between China and the US began in November 2018. The talks did not yield desired results even after many rounds of negotiations in both China and the US.

Ocean Dance Festival begins in Cox's Bazar

Ocean Dance Festival of Bangladesh is going to be held in the longest sea beach, Cox's Bazar from 22nd-25th November. World Dance Alliance will organize the show "Dashavatar" in association with cultural organization Dhriti Nartanalaya on 24th November, 2019 in the district. Dashavatar – means 10 different forms of Hindu God "Lord Krishna."

Saudi Arabia officially approves Aramco oil IPO

- The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's financial regulator officially gave the green light to the initial public offering (IPO) of its state-run oil company Saudi Aramco, a move that had been promised by Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman since 2016. It is one of the largest companies in the world and could result in the largest-ever IPO.
- The listing announcement was made by the Capital Market Authority, the government's financial regulatory agency.

Freedom on Net 2019 report-China the worst abuser of internet freedom

- The Freedom of Net report 2019 titled "The Crisis of Social Media" was released by the The Freedom House, an international watchdog. The report recorded an overall decline in global internet freedom status between July 2018 and May 2019.
- India obtained an overall score of 55 and was reported to be "partly free".

Google celebrates 30th anniversary of fall of Berlin Wall

• German marks the 30th anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall with rallies, memorials, and exhibitions. A bronze statue of late US President Ronald Reagan, clutching the cards inscribed with his 1987 speech challenging Mikhail Gorbachev, was unveiled by US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo in Germany's capital city on the eve of the 30th anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall. The statue located in the US Embassy overlooks the landmark.

Pakistan: First Country to introduce WHO approved Typhoid Vaccine

• Pakistan becomes the first country to introduce WHO approved typhoid vaccine. The Vaccine is to be used in southern Sindh province as more than 10,000 cases of Typhoid were documented since 2017.

Dhaka Global Dialogue held in Bangladesh

- The leaders discussed the threat to extremism and terrorism and agreed to work closely. The meeting on terrorism is important for India's interests in the Indo-Pacific region.
- Also, they discussed on trade, investment and connectivity and Indo-Pacific

Manipur most violent NE state: Report

- Manipur has emerged as the most violent north-eastern state in 2018. According to a union home ministry report, it accounted for 50 per cent of the total incidents reported across the region last year.
- Manipur witnessed a decline in insurgency-related incidents by 24 per cent compared to 167 in 2017, and civilian deaths went down from 23 in 2017 to eight in 2018. A total of 127 violent incidents were reported in Manipur in 2018.
- In comparision, 252 similar incidents were reported from entire north-eastern region. In 2018, counter insurgency operations led to the neutralization of 10 militants, arrest of 404 militants and recovery of 99 weapons in Manipur.

Mukesh Ambani overtakes Larry Page, Sergey Brin to become 9th richest in the world

- With a net worth of USD 60 billion, Reliance Industries chief Mukesh Ambani has been ranked the 9th richest person globally, according to 'The Real-Time Billionaires List' of Forbes, that was topped by Amazon Founder and CEO Jeff Bezos.
- The list tracks the daily ups and downs of the world's richest people and reflects changes since 5 pm EST of the previous trading day. Ambani was ranked 13th in the annual Forbes' rich list for 2019.

Mumbai tops ranking for tap water quality; Delhi finishes at bottom

- Union minister Ram Vilas Paswan said that tap water in Delhi and several other cities did not comply with the requirements according to a study conducted by the Bureau of Indian standards.
- "Mumbai tops ranking released by the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) for quality of tap water. Delhi is at the bottom, with 11 out of 11 samples failing on 19 parameters," Paswan said while addressing a press conference here on Saturday.

Delhi was the most polluted major city in the world on Friday: AirVisual data

• Delhi was the most polluted major city in the world with an air quality index (AQI) of 527, as per data by AirVisual on the World AQI rankings. Six of the 10 most polluted cities fall in the Indian sub-continent including Delhi, Lahore, Karachi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Kathmandu. Mumbai is in ninth place with AQI of 153.

Bribery Risk Index: Bangladesh has highest risk in South Asia

• Bangladesh has been identified as the "country with the highest risk" in terms of bribery threats in South Asia, according to the latest Global Bribery Risk Index. In the updated index report titled Trace Bribery Risk Matrix, Bangladesh scored 72 out of 100 this year, which is two points higher than last year. The global average score is 51.

Dutee Chand named in TIME 100 Next list

• India sprinter Dutee Chand has been named in the TIME 100 Next, an expansion of the TIME 100 list of the most influential persons in the world. The list, an initiative of TIME magazine, highlights 100 rising stars who are shaping the future of business, entertainment, sports, politics, health, science, activism etc.

Mumbai named as the worlds worst cities to drive

- The Driving Cities Index released by European car parts retailer Mister Auto, a part of the PSA Group, reported that Mumbai and Kolkata had been rated as the world's worst cities to drive in 2019. The retailer released a detailed study on the best and worst places in the world to drive in.
- The three main parameters that were considered by the study that impacts the driving condition are Infrastructure, Safety, and Costs. These three main categories were then broken down into 15 sub-categories.

JK Grameen Bank ranked first among the 56 RRBs across India

 J&K Grameen Bank secured the top position in terms of achievement of Rupay Card transaction targets (POS and eCOM). It has been ranked first among the 56 RRBs across the country. National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) survey reported that Bank had achieved a 94.95% target for POS/ eCOM transactions for the last financial year 2018-19.

India Justice Report, 2019: Ranking states on Police, Judiciary, Prisons & Legal Aid

- This is the first-ever ranking of Indian states on justice delivery. The report has divided states on the basis of the population into two parts:
- The large-medium states (Population 1 crore and above)
- The small states and Union Territories (Population less than 1 crore)
- Maharashtra has topped the list among large-medium States followed by Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, and Haryana. In this category, Jharkhand, Bihar and Uttar Pradesh are at the bottom. Goa leads the list of smaller states followed by Sikkim and Himachal Pradesh.
- The report has been prepared based on publicly available data of different government entities on the four pillars of justice delivery police, judiciary, prisons, and legal aid.

Report: India-2nd largest in sending students to US

- On November 18, 2019, the "2019 Open Doors Report on International Educational Exchange" was released. According to the report, India remained the largest source of foreign students to the US for the 10th consecutive year.
- This year alone, India has sent around 202,000 students to the US. It is the second largest number of foreign students from a country to the US. The first largest source is China.

India ranks 59th in 2019 IMD World Talent Ranking

• India was ranked 59th among 63 countries in the 2019 IMD World Talent Ranking released by International Institute for Management Development. This year, India slipped by 6 places as compared to 53rd rank in 2018 edition of this global annual list. India's poor performance was on account of low quality of life and expenditure on education.

Microsoft CEO Nadella tops Fortune's Businessperson of the Year 2019 list

 Microsoft CEO Satya Nadella topped Fortune's Businessperson of the Year 2019 list released by the American business magazine. Fortune ranked business leaders based on the challenges they faced and listed "Assembling the right team" as Nadella's challenge. He was followed by Australia's Fortescue Metals Group CEO Elizabeth Gaines and Chipotle Mexican Grill's CEO Brian Niccol on the list.

Bangalore, Delhi, Mumbai make it on new global prosperity index

- Bangalore emerged as India's highest ranked city at No. 83 in a new index of the world's 113 cities in terms of economic and social inclusivity, topped by Zurich in Switzerland.
- The first-ever Prosperity & Inclusion City Seal and Awards (PICSA) Index, released in the Basque Country capital of Bilbao in northern Spain evening, is designed to

showcase not only the quantity of economic growth of a city but also its quality and distribution across populations.

India ranks third in terms of mobile VPN downloads: Report

• India has emerged as the country with the third-highest number of VPN downloads, after Indonesia and the US, as per a Top10VPN report. From October 2018 till September 2019, the VPN downloads in India grew the most globally by 405% to 57 million. Virtual Private Networks (VPNs) allow users to hide their IP address to bypass geo-blocks and government censorship.

UNICEF Report: India Second largest in Pneumonia deaths

- On November 14, 2019, United Nations' new report on Pneumonia stated that India has the second largest deaths of children under the age of five due to Pneumonia in 2018. Globally more than 800,000 children died due to Pneumonia under the age of 5.
- The report stated that though the disease is preventable through vaccines, more than 10 million die annually due to the disease

Sun Pharma pacts with AstraZeneca to develop oncology products for China

• Sun Pharmaceutical Industries Ltd entered into a licensing agreement with AstraZeneca UK Ltd. The partnership aims to introduce new infusion oncology products in China. It aims to introduce specialty and generics products in the China market and the licensing agreement.

- Truecaller plans to use its payments platform to foray into credit business early 2020, turning it into a complete fin-tech company, co-founder Nami Zarringhalam said here.
- In an exclusive interview to the PTI at the company headquarters, Nami said the Truecaller is becoming a "superapp", providing a spectrum of services to its consumers.

Ola and Microsoft come together to measure air quality on the streets of India's national capital

• Indian ride hailing unicorn Ola and global tech giant Microsoft inked a partnership to measure real-time street air quality index in Delhi. The national capital's residents have been gasping for air for over three weeks now as air quality index (AQI) levels have spiked beyond 1000 leading to an emergency-like situation.

RIL became first Indian firm to cross Rs.9.5 lakh crore m-cap

Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) became the first Indian firm to cross the Rs.9.5 lakh crore market capitalization mark. Reliance Industries share price rose up to 3.66% to Rs.1,511.9 compared to the previous close of Rs.1,458.50 on BSE. In October 2019, RIL hit the milestone as the first Indian company to cross the staggering Rs.9 lakh crore market-cap mark.

PayPal is buying deal-finding service Honey for \$4 billion, its biggest acquisition ever

- PayPal is making the biggest acquisition in its two-decade history, announcing that it's buying Honey Science for about \$4 billion.
- Honey, which is best known for providing a service that helps consumers find deals while they shop online, works with 30,000 online retailers and claims to have 17 million monthly users. PayPal said Honey's technology will help it reach consumers as they begin their "shopping journeys" with personalized offers.

ACI Worldwide, Microsoft strike cloud partnership in payments space

• ACI Worldwide, a global provider of real-time electronic payment and banking solutions, announced a global strategic collaboration with Microsoft via the Microsoft Partner Network to support the payments industry's rapid adoption of technology deployed in the public cloud.

Amazon launches 'Project Zero' in India to block counterfeit goods

• In a bid to ensure that customers receive authentic goods when shopping on Amazon. Amazon announced to bring "Project Zero" to India. "Project Zero" introduces additional proactive mechanisms and powerful tools to identify, block and remove counterfeits.

CCI approves Adani's 23.5% stake-buy in Mumbai International Airport

• The competition watchdog approved the acquisition of 23.5% stake in Mumbai International Airport Ltd (MIAL) by Adani Properties Private Limited (APPL). APPL is set to acquire 13.5% stake in MIAL from Bid Services Division (Mauritius) Limited and 10% stake from ACSA Global Limited.

Dustlik 2019: India Uzbekistan joint Military Exercise

• India will conduct its first ever military exercise with Uzbekistan in a 10-day session on counter terrorism tactics. The exercise will be held at Chirchiq Training Area, Uzbekistan between November 4 and November 13, 2019. The Defence Minister Shri Raj Nath Singh during his 3 day visit met the Indian contingent participating in the joint exercise.

India, Uzbekistan to sign MoUs for military medicine and military education

• India and Uzbekistan are planning to sign two memorandum of understanding (MOUs) concerning military medicine and military education. The 2 MoUs were signed during the three-day visit of the Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh to Uzbekistan, the Central Asian nation.

Tiger TRIUMP: First Tri-services amphibious exercise between India and US

 India and US are to jointly conduct Tiger TRIUMP, the first ever tri-services amphibious exercise. It is to be conducted in Visakhapatnam and Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh. It includes field training and events that simulate humanitarian assistance in disaster times. The event will also hold simulations in moving disaster relief forces from ship to shore.

Samudra Shakti: India- Indonesian Joint Naval exercise

• The Navies of India and Indonesia are holding bilateral naval exercise called 'Samudra Shakti' in Bay of Bengal on 6-7 November 2019. This year is the second edition of India, Indonesia Bilateral Naval Exercise. The inaugural edition of exercise was held at the port of Surabaya, Indonesia in November 2018.

IAF launches multiplayer version of 'Indian Air Force – A Cut Above' game

• The Indian Air Force (IAF) launched the multiplayer version of its interactive mobile game named 'Indian Air Force – A Cut Above'. The game lets users experience the thrill of flying a combat aircraft. The single-player version of the game was first launched by then Chief of Air Staff (COAS), B S Dhanoa, on 31 May 2019.

Indian Navy Commissions Sixth Dornier Aircraft Squadron In Gujarat

- The Indian Navy has commissioned its sixth Dornier aircraft squadron in strategically located Porbandar town of Gujarat, giving a fillip to coastal security near the sea border with Pakistan.
- The Indian Naval Air Squadron 314, called Raptors, which will operate with four newly-inducted, next generation Dornier aircraft, was commissioned by Deputy Chief of Naval Staff Vice-Admiral MS Pawar.

Indian Army conducts Sindhu Sudarshan exercise in Barmer, Rajasthan

• The Strike Corps (also known as Sudarshan Chakra Corps) of Indian Army is conducting the annually held exercise, dubbed Sindu Sudarshan-VII, in Barmer, Rajasthan. The annual exercise will test the operational readiness and maneuver warfare capability of Indian Army's 21 Corps, one of the service's three so-called Strike Corps. The Corps currently consists of 2 infantry divisions, 1 armored division, and 3 support brigades.

Bilateral Maritime Exercise Zair Al Bahr is being held in Doha

- The Bilateral Maritime Exercise Za'ir-Al-Bahr, Roar of the Sea, is being conducted from 17-21 November 2019 in Doha, Qatar. The exercise is held between the Indian Navy and Qatari Emiri Naval Forces.
- Aim:
- The five-day bilateral exercise aims to strengthen cooperation and enhance interoperability between the Indian Navy and Qatari Emiri Naval Forces.

Indian Navy test-fires Brahmos supersonic cruise missile

- Indian Navy test-fired the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile, from the Navy's stealth destroyer INS Kochi. The supersonic missile successfully hit a decommissioned target ship in Arabian Sea. Moreover, the second ship of Project 15-A 'Kolkata-class' guided missile destroyer test-fired advanced missile during a naval drill in west coast.
- Earlier the BrahMos missile has been successfully test fired twice from INS Kolkata, (one in June 2014 and February 2015) and one successful test firing has been from INS Kochi in November 2015. The recent test firing from INS Kochi has now re-validated ship's precise strike capability.

CARAT- 2019: US-Bangladesh Navy exercise

• The biggest US- Bangladesh Navy exercise dubbed as 'Cooperation Afloat Readiness and Training (CARAT) – 2019' is being held in Chattogram (or Chittagong City) in Bangladesh. The CARAT is a yearly exercise conducted between the navies of Bangladesh and United States in the Bay of Bengal. The first edition of exercise was held in 2011.

Science and Technology

11,000 scientists in 153 countries declare climate emergency

- In a paper published in the journal BioScience, 11,258 signatories (69 from India) declared Global Climate Emergency. They presented climate change trends and methods to mitigate the threat. The report was titled "World Scientists"
- It is based on the scientific analysis of more than 40 years of publicly available data. It illustrates several key climate change indicators since the scientists from 50 nations met at the First World Climate Conference in Geneva in 1979.

Voyager 2: NASA's Solar System Explorer reaches interstellar space

- NASA's Voyager 2 has exited heliosphere and has entered interstellar space. It is now at 11 billion miles from the earth. Information from the spacecraft takes 16.5 hours to reach earth at the speed of light. (Light from the sun takes 8 minutes to reach earth)
- The spacecraft joined its twin voyager 1 on December 10, 2018. The Voyagers were launched to study the outer solar system up close. Voyager 2 will target Saturn, Jupiter, Neptune and Uranus.

India completes Agni II test fire successfully

• India on November 11, 2019, conducted its first night trial of AGNI II missile successfully. It is the first night trial being tested by the country. The nuclear capable missile was tested at the Abdul Kalam Island of Odisha Coast.

IIT-Madras launches country's first standing wheelchair: Arise

• Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras has launched country's first indigenously designed standing wheelchair named as 'Arise' in presence of Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment Thawarchand Gehlot at the institute.

University Of Michigan to Collaborate With AIIMS, KMC On Genetic Testing

- National Institute of Health (NIH) of \$2.3 million helps a University of Michigan researcher to collaborate with India's premier health-education institutes, AIIMS and Kasturba Medical College (KMC)Manipal to expand genetic testing in the country.
- This partnership would help the geneticists to identify and confirm that genetic changes are the basis of developmental disorders. An accurate molecular diagnosis can dramatically improve the care management of individuals with rare developmental disorders and involved treatments.

NASA: A Huge X Ray burst detected from outer space

• NASA's NICER (Neutron star Interior Composition Explorer) telescope detected a sudden spike of X Rays. The spike was caused by a massive thermo nuclear flash on the surface of a pulsar.

IIT Guwahati researchers develop paper based sensor that detects freshness of milk

- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Guwahati researchers have developed a paperbased sensor that can make an assessment of the freshness of milk by a simple and instantaneous method. The quality and freshness of milk are decided by the invasion and presence of microbes in the milk.
- Bacteria and other microbes that can grow in milk can not only affect the taste and freshness, but can also result in health issues. Pasteurization is commonly used to kill the microbes in milk and various tests are used to ensure the effectiveness of pasteurization.

Pakistan successfully test fires Shaheen-1 surface-to-surface ballistic missile

- Pakistan conducted successful test launch of Shaheen-1 surface-to-surface ballistic missile. The test was conducted part of a training exercise aimed at testing the operational readiness of Army Strategic Forces Command for ensuring Pakistan's credible minimum deterrence.
- The test come days after India conducted the first night trial of Agni-II surface-to-surface medium range nuclear-capable missile having strike range of 2,000 km.

ISRO to Launch 13 satellites and Cartosat-3

• The Indian Space Research Organization will launch 13 commercial nano satellites of the United States along with the imaging and mapping satellite Cartostat-3. The launch is scheduled on November 25, 2019.

New 'warm Jupiter' exoplanet discovered

- Astronomers have reported the discovery of a new "warm Jupiter" exoplanet that is transiting a main sequence late F-type star. The newfound exoplanet, designated TOI-677 b, is about 20% bigger and more massive than Jupiter.
- The "warm Jupiter" planets are gas giant planets with a minimal mass of 0.3 Jupiter masses and orbital periods ranging between 10 and 100 days.

Astronomers Have Detected Record-Breaking Light Emissions From Gamma-Ray Bursts

- Scientists have managed to see two violent explosions in galaxies that are billions of light-years away. The results from the study published in the journal Nature. The explosions were gamma-rays bursts or short eruptions of the most energetic form of light.
- The second captured in January, produced light that contained 100 billion times as much energy as the light visible to human eyes. The telescopes (Hubble Space Telescope) on Earth had to catch the light barely 50 seconds after the Gamma-ray bursts appeared since they last for only a few seconds. The Major Atmospheric Gamma Imaging Cherenkov (MAGIC) telescopes in the Canary Islands were the first to see the bursts.

ISRO launches CARTOSAT-3, 13 nano satellites from Sriharikota

• India's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle-XL (PSLV-XL) rocket carrying advanced earth observation satellite Cartosat-3 and 13 US nano satellites lifted off from the second launch pad of the rocket port here. At about 9.28 a.m. the 44.4 metre tall, weighing 320 ton rocket blasted off from the second launch pad at the country's rocket port here. The launch was normal despite a clouded sky. According to ISRO, the 1,625 kg Cartosat-3 is an advanced agile satellite to obtain panchromatic and multispectral imagery with an operational life of five years.

Researchers discovered a massive black hole in the Milky Way

Researchers from the National Astronomical Observatory of China have discovered a
black hole in the Milky Way. The black hole is so huge that it challenged the existing
models of the evolution of stars. The black hole was discovered by an international
team of scientists using China's sophisticated Large Sky Area Multi-Object Fibre
Spectroscopic Telescope (LAMOST) telescope.

Tree rings can predict climate change: Asian Dendrochronology Conference

- Reconstructions of past responses of vegetation from different ecosystems can predict
 the impact of climate change on weather and other environmental parameters, scientists
 said at the 6th Asian Dendrochronology Conference being held at the Birbal Sahni
 Institute of Palaeosciences in Lucknow.
- This is the first time that the conference is being held in India. The studies presented and deliberated at the conference were mostly from different ecological niches within Asia.

Marengo Sachintendulkar: Newly discovered spider species named after cricketer

- Dhruv Prajapati, a junior researcher pursuing a PhD in spider taxonomy with Gujarat Ecological Education & Research (GEER) Foundation, recently discovered two new species of spiders.
- He has named one of the species as Marengo sachintendulkar after Indian crickter Sachin Tendulkar and other as Indomarengo Chavarapatera which is inspired by Saint Kuriakose Elias Chavara who was a campaigned towards creating awareness about education in Kerala.
